

Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish

- * Sheen levels available: Matt, Satin
- * Suitable for floors

What does it do?

Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish enhances the wood to bring out its natural grain pattern and colour. It is easy-to-use and is suitable for heavy domestic use. It has a self-levelling formula.

What is it used for?

Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish is perfect for both softwood and hardwood floors, doors, furniture and stair parts. On resinous or very dense hardwoods such as Rosewood, check that **Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish** is bonding correctly before use, and if not, use **Finney's Durapolish Clear Glaze (Finish No.6)** instead.

How do you use it?

Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish is simply stirred well and applied along the grain using a **Trade Synthetic Brush**. On floors, conventional floor applicators and rollers can be used. In between coats lightly cut back with **400g grit Wet 'N' Dry** abrasive paper (used dry), and remove any dust using a **Tack Cloth**. It's as simple as that!

How long does it take to dry?

Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish is touch and re-coat dry in around 1 hour. Light traffic 4 hours. Full cure 5 days. We usually recommend a maximum of **two** applications in any 12 hour period.

Staining

Use **Finney's Professional Water Stains** to colour wood.

- To achieve the dry colour of the stain, add around 15% of the **Extra Tough Floor Varnish** into the stain to act as a binding agent before use.
- To achieve the wet colour of the stain, apply a single coat of **Finney's Transparent Fixative** after staining and then apply the required number of coats of **Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish**.

How much do I need?

2-3 coats are generally required - 3 coats on floors. Coverage is approximately:

- 10sq m per litre per coat on softwood
- 12sq m per litre per coat on hardwoods such as oak
