What does it do?

Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish is self-levelling and gives the appearance, but more protection, of a top quality Hardwax Oil.

It can be used as a stand-alone wood finish or, for more protection on floors and other surfaces, one or two coats of **Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish** can be applied first, followed by one or two coats of **Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish**.

What is it used for?

Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish is used on floors, doors, furniture and stair parts. It pulls out the natural colour and grain pattern of the wood.

How do you use it?

Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish is very easy to use. STIR WELL and apply in thin coats using a **Trade Synthetic Brush** along the grain. In between coats, lightly cut back (denib) with **400 grit / 600 grit Wet 'N' Dry** abrasive paper (used dry), and remove any dust using a **Tack Cloth**.

How long does it take to dry?

Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish is generally touch and re-coat dry in around 45 minutes. Full cure 5 days. We usually recommend a maximum of **two** applications in any 12 hour period.

Staining

Use Finney's Professional Water Stains to colour wood.

- To achieve the <u>dry</u> colour of the stain, add around 15% of **Finney's Trade Acrylic Varnish** or **Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish** into the stain to act as a binding agent before use.
- To achieve the <u>wet</u> colour of the stain, apply a single coat of **Finney's Transparent Fixative** after staining and then apply the required number of coats of **Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish**.

How much do I need?

2-3 coats are generally required depending on porosity of wood. If using **Finney's Extra Tough Floor Varnish** as a primer coat to increase protection, only 1 or 2 coats of **Finney's Extra Tough Waxed Finish** would be applied on top (see 'What does it do?' above)
